

## **Darrel W. and Dorothy J. Anderson Endowed Scholarship**

This endowed fund was established by Darrel W. and Dorothy J. Anderson in honor of their families. This scholarship is dedicated to providing funds to support a Theatre major based on need. One endowed scholarship is awarded each year and award amounts fluctuate yearly depending on funding. Scholarships can be awarded to eligible applicants/students a maximum of two times.

The terms of the award are as follows:

### **CONDITIONS OF AWARD**

1. Each recipient award will be applied as a partial tuition payment to the following academic year. The tuition award will be paid directly to the student's account. (Tuition awards do not cover university fees, books, or other educational expenses.)
2. Students are eligible to receive the scholarship a maximum of two times.
3. Students who have received the award previously must reapply and will be evaluated on the same basis as all other applicants.
4. If a student does not receive an award one year, they may reapply the following year.

### **QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE AWARD**

1. The candidate must be a UMBC undergraduate.
2. The candidate must not be a current recipient of a Linehan Artist Scholar award.
3. The candidate must be an officially declared theatre major who has spent at least two semesters in the Theatre Department.
4. The candidate, upon application, must have achieved a GPA of at least 3.0. This average must be maintained once the scholarship is awarded.
5. The candidate, upon acceptance, must have completed at least 24 semester hours of academic work at UMBC.

6. The student must demonstrate financial need.
7. Upon application, transfer students who have enrolled at UMBC with junior standing (48 completed semester hours, or their equivalent) must have completed at least 12 semester hours at UMBC.

#### SCHOLARSHIP DECISIONS

1. Final decisions will be made by a committee of full-time faculty.
2. Financial need is a requirement for this scholarship award.
3. Standards for the awards are determined by the faculty. Scholarships will only be awarded if the faculty standards and award qualifications are met. Awards are based upon the applicant's record of quality academic achievement, departmental participation, overall commitment to the theatre learning experience, and financial need.
4. The Department Chair has authority to render immediate adjustment and financial decisions as appropriate when timely.
